

"Introduction to PC/OA Testing" is an introductory course designed to teach current CDOT and AASHTO test procedures used in the Process Control (PC) and Owner Acceptance (OA) of asphalt materials. This training is useful for entry level technicians who are preparing for asphalt technician certification, as well as seasoned technicians who may be re-entering the testing arena. Inspectors and Engineers who want more knowledge about testing procedures, how they are to be carried out during a paving project, and basic information on how test results may affect the quality of the pavement will benefit from this course.

The training includes classroom instruction and hands-on experience in the laboratory. **The course** format is divided into four separate one-day courses, covering one level per day. Participants may register for any combination depending on the information desired.
