

Trends for 2021

- Approx. 62,000 lane miles managed by Local Agencies captured in this survey.
- Representing **93%** of Local Agency asphalt paved roads statewide.
- **Over \$320M** budgeted for Annual Street Improvement Programs.
- **Over \$358M** budgeted for Capital Improvement Programs.
- Mill & Overlay programs increased funding on average **+3.5%** vs. 2020.
- Maintenance programs maintained funding levels vs. 2020.
- Funding \$ / lane mile increased
 +8% from \$4,895 in 2020.
