100th Avenue Sidewalk Multimodal Path

- Design Bid Build
- Estimated ad Q2 2026
- Bid Net
- \$1.5M, Trails, Grading, Drainage, Signage, CDOT federal Funds
- This project constructs a detached sidewalk along the north side of 100th Avenue from the northeast corner of Riverdale Road to the existing sidewalk west of West Forest Circle. The project includes streetlights, restriping crosswalks, and ADA ramps on the northwest and southwest corners of 100th Avenue and Riverdale Road.

136th Avenue Bridge at Big Dry Creek

This project will widen the south side of the 136th Avenue bridge over the Big Dry Creek. This will provide an additional eastbound lane from Grant Street to Washington Street where the lane will become a right turn lane to southbound Washington Street.

104th Ave Widening from Colorado to Platte River Bridge

- \$30M, Paving, grading, trails, drainage, signage, concrete, sidewalks, traffic signal improvements. The project consists of widening 104th Avenue between Colorado Boulevard and Platte River Bridge to a five-lane section with bike lanes, shared use paths, sidewalks, and two through lanes in each direction with a center turn lane. Major intersections will be evaluated for double left and right turn lanes as well as traffic signal modifications. Additional funding approved by the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG) to complete design from Colorado Boulevard to the west side of the Platte River bridge. US Department of Transportation Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant funds approved for construction. Federally Funded. CDOT oversight

Thornton Parkway Multi-Use Path

Adams County anticipates the following programs and projects in 2026:

- **2026 Street Paving Program:**

This program will improve paved streets identified as priorities for rehabilitation through the County's Transportation Asset Management System. It represents a significant street maintenance effort, covering approximately 50 lane-miles within the unincorporated Adams County. Advertisement on Bid Net is anticipated by the end of January or early February 2026. Budget will be less than \$9 million.

- **2026 Seal Program:**

This maintenance program involves applying seal treatments to various streets, covering approximately 43 lane-miles within the unincorporated Adams County. Advertisement on Bid Net is planned for the end of February or early March 2026. Budget will be less than \$1 million.

- **2026 Concrete Program**

This year's program will focus on concrete maintenance requests that the County has received from residents countywide and other locations in the County as funding allows. Advertisement on Bid Net is planned for the end of February. Budget will be less than \$400,000.
